## **Information about Infant/Child Seats & Tether Anchors**

Children 8 years or older do not need a child seat of any sort.

Infant/child seats can be placed on the Couch or in the Dinette. The dinette can hold up to two infant/child seats and is the recommended location for children under 4 years of age. The Couch is only suitable for children 4 years of age or older. The staff at the rental counter can show the clients the best place in the motorhome to secure the infant/child seat.

In these vehicles, up to 2 infant/child seats can be placed on the seats located behind the driver and so are only suitable options for parties with a maximum of 2 children under 8 years of age:

• Mighty Class B [MB] 20-22ft:

In these vehicles, the only place to affix infant/child seats is the dinette and so are only suitable options for parties with a maximum of 2 children under 8 years of age:

- El Monte RV Class C Small [C] 21-23ft
- Road Bear RV Class C Motorhome Non-Slide (M) 23-25'
- El Monte RV Class C Medium [D] 24-26ft
- Mighty Class C Medium [MD] 24-26ft

There is both a couch and a dinette in these vehicles and therefore are suitable options for parties with no more than 4 children under 8 years of age as long as only 2 are under 4 years of age:

- Road Bear RV Class C Motorhome W/Slide-Out (P) 26-28':
- El Monte RV Class C Large [T] 27-29ft
- Mighty Class C Large [MT] 27-29ft:
- El Monte RV Class C Family Sleeper [FS] 30-32ft
- Road Bear RV Class C Motorhome W/Slide-Out (R) 29-31'
- Mighty Class A [MA] 31-34ft

**Tether anchor:** Tether anchor is not required in the USA. There is no tether in in any of the Class B or Class A motorhomes. The other motorhome unit types all have have one Tether anchor. Although tether anchor is not required in the USA, if the vehicle has a tether anchor, they are welcome to use it.

**Britz USA:** Most of the Britz USA motorhomes are equipped with 1 tether anchor, but not all. The Britz vehicles may include class B which are not equipped with a tether anchor. However, since tether anchors is not required in the USA, the Britz vehicles can all hold up to 2 seats for small children or infant or children under the age of 8.
