It is the customer's responsibility to install the child restraint in the vehicle. Branch staff are not certified to fit them or advise on how they should be fitted.



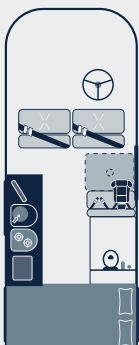
New Zealand legislation

By law, all children up to seven years of age must be secured in the correct child car restraint according to their size and age. A child may stop using a child restraint once they turn seven or if their seated shoulder height is above the top mark of the restraint or their eye level is above the back of the booster seat. A child under seven cannot sit in the front row of a vehicle with more than one row of seats. For more information, please visit [link](#).

Seat compliance

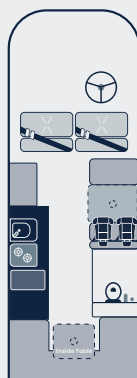
Star RV does not recommend bringing your own car seat with you as our car seats have already been certified for NZ. However, should you need to please follow the compliance: Overseas child restraints can be used in NZ if they meet one of the following guidelines: AS/NZ 1734, FMVSS 213 or an E rating.

Vehicles & anchor points



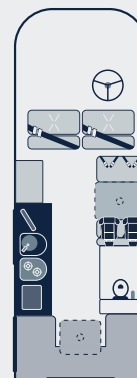
Polaris 2

- 2 anchor points located behind headrests of forward-facing seats in rear.
- Fits one booster seat and one child seat or two booster seats.



Polaris 4

- 2 anchor points
- 2 located behind headrests of forward-facing seats in rear



Polaris 6

- 2 anchor points
- 2 located behind headrests of forward-facing seats in rear
