Weight	Up to 9kg (19lbs)	9 kg - 30kg (19 - 66 lbs)	18kg and over (39lbs and over)
Direction	Rear	Rear if under 9 kg. Rear or front, if over 9 kg. Front, if over 18 kg.	Front
Notes	Dinette table may need lowering as Infant or Child Seats are installed, making it un-available for adults during travel	Children 9–18 kg should remain rear-facing as long as possible. (Source: BCAA road-safety / child-passenger-safety).	No car seat needed for children over 145 cm (4'9")

2x three-point belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x infant, child or booster seats

2x lap belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x child seats (no booster seats)

C-Medium

1x lap belt (+ 1 tether hook)
1x child seat, front-facing only (no infant or booster seats)

Run of Fleet C-Class

2x three-point belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x infant, child or booster seats

2x lap belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x child seats (no booster seats)

C-Large

2x three-point belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x infant, child or booster seats

2x lap belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x child seats (no booster seats)


C-XLarge

2x lap belts (+ 2 tether hooks)
2x infant or child seats (no booster seats)

3x lap belts
no child seats installable

- Lap belt with tether hook: child seat, front-facing only (no infant or booster seats)
- No child seats installable: Dinette table may need to be lowered when infant or child seats are installed

Please note that it is not illegal for children to sit in dinette seats with lap belts only, without a booster seat. In vehicles like the C-XLarge, which are equipped with lap belts (not shoulder belts), the main risk that boosters address — choking from a misaligned seat belt — does not apply. Children around 5 years or older may use these seats, but the final decision rests with the customer. Four Seasons RV Rentals provides guidelines but does not make decisions on child seating.
